ACNE ADVANCED TREATMENT PROTOCOL

With Encapsulated Salicylic Acid

1) **Cleansing:** Acne Advanced Cleansing Foam

Pump a small amount of the **Acne Advanced Cleansing Foam** and apply to skin. Gently massage with fingertips in a circular motion covering the face and neck. Rinse with warm water or remove with a warm washcloth and pat dry.

2) Exfoliation: Pro Salicylic Acid Peel 15%

FOR ACNE AND BLEMISHED SKINS: A preliminary patch test is advised before a general application is made: cleanse skin behind the ear, apply the product and leave undisturbed for 3 to 5 minutes. If no unnatural reaction occurs, apply the product as directed. Contact of the product with the skin must be of limited frequency or duration. Do not use on broken or abraded skin.

Apply the **Pro Salicylic Acid Peel 15%** to dry skin on the face and neck using a fan brush or gloved fingers. Leave on for 3 to 5 minutes maximum.

NOTE: Assess application time based on client tolerance. Remove with a damp cloth. Follow immediately with the **Soothing Chamomile Tonique** sprayed on a cotton pad. Rinse thoroughly with cool water and pat dry.

3) Masque to be used after peel: Acne Advanced Clarifying Masque

Apply a small amount of the **Acne Advanced Clarifying Masque** evenly over the entire face and neck. Allow to dry for 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water and pat dry.

NOTE: Option to use as a spot treatment.

4) Moisturizing: Acne Advanced Clarifying Hydrator

Apply a thin layer of the Acne Advanced Clarifying Hydrator to face, neck and décolleté and leave on.

Note: After application of a peel treatment, skin will be more sensitive to the sun. Application of an SPF product is mandatory after treatment. Advise your client to use a sunscreen, wear protective clothing, and limit sun exposure after each treatment and for a week afterwards. Apply **Sun Defense Minerals SPF 30** as per instructions to finish and protect your client's skin.
